CID Offers \$5,000 Reward in Vehicle Vandalism Case

QUANTICO, VA, Mar 5, 2013 – The U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command, commonly referred to as CID, is offering a \$5,000 reward to anyone with information leading to the identification and successful prosecution of the individual(s) involved in the vandalism of numerous vehicles on Fort Drum, New York.

Multiple vehicles, mostly parked on North Lewis Avenue in the Richard Hills Housing Area, were vandalized sometime between night of December 14, 2012 and the following morning. Additional damage was discovered on several vehicles parked on Middle Lewis Avenue and another parked on South Lewis Avenue.

The unknown person(s) slashed and punctured all four tires on the vehicles and may have sustained a cut during the commission of the crime. The estimated total value of damage to private property is \$25,000 to \$30,000.
