Soldier Apprehended in Connection with Knox Shooting

QUANTICO, VA, April 4, 2013 – The U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command, commonly referred to as CID, announced today that a Soldier assigned to Fort Knox's 3rd Brigade Combat Team, 1st Infantry Division was apprehended for questioning in connection with the shooting death of a Department of the Army civilian employee.

The shooting occurred Wednesday at approximately 5:40 p.m., in a parking lot outside the U.S. Army Human Resources Command (HRC) Headquarters on Fort Knox, Ky.

The Soldier was apprehended in Tennessee by Portland Police and CID Special Agents.

"Special Agents from the U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command are continuing the investigation and as previously released, the shooting appears to be a domestic issue and not a random act of violence," said Chris Grey, spokesperson for Army CID.
