Fort Hood Special Agents Seek Assistance from Public



FORT BELVOIR, Virginia, December 6, 2007 -- The U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command, commonly known as CID, is asking the public to assist in identifying the man in these sketches, who is wanted for questioning by Fort Hood CID Special Agents in connection with possible kidnapping attempts in the Kouma Village Housing Area, Fort Hood, Texas.

The suspect, identified as a dark-skinned male, was seen driving a red, mid-sized two-door sedan on one occasion and a white, four door mid-sized sedan on a second occasion.
