REQUESTS FOR AMENDMENT OF DACID RECORDS

Public Law 116-283 (William M. (Mac) Thornberry National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2021), section 545 (Removal of Personally Identifying and Other Information of Certain Persons from Investigative Reports, The Department of Defense Central Index of Investigations, and Other Records and Databases), required the Secretary of Defense to establish and maintain a policy and process for a person to request their Department of Defense (DoD) law enforcement record be amended, corrected, expunged, or otherwise removed when it is determined probable cause did not or does not exist to believe that the individual committed the alleged criminal offense(s).

In August 2023, DoDI 5505.7 was changed to reflect that covered persons titled in DoD Law Enforcement Activity (LEA) reports or indexed in Defense Central Index of Investigations (DCII) may request their information be corrected in, expunged, or otherwise removed from DoD LEA reports, DCII, and related records systems, databases, or repositories maintained by, or on behalf of, DoD LEAs to include Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) National Crime Information Center (NCIC) and National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS).

Amendments must be in writing, and either digitally signed or provided along with a government issued identification (i.e., military id, driver's license, social security card). All requests should include the requester's name, social security number, address or email, date of birth and if known, the responsive case number.
