## MAJOR ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Authored and implemented a major change in polygraph testing protocol that significantly increased test result reliability.

Conducted a Korea-wide fraud investigation that led to 38 criminal cases, a \$2 million recovery, the arrest of 35 foreign national drug traffickers, and subsequent seizure of \$3 million in illicit drugs.

Played a major role in the development and resourcing of multiple criminal investigative organizations, to include the CID Computer Crimes Investigative Unit and a data-sharing crosswalk that lead to the establishment of the National Counterterrorism Center.
