MAJOR ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Advocated for the presence of CID Agents in support of the Joint Terrorism Task Force (JTTF) after the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001, which profoundly affected relations between CID and the FBI.

Extraordinary achievements in covert operations; directly responsible for the seizure of narcotics and dangerous drugs representing a street value of millions of dollars and the arrest of several international drug traffickers.

Awarded the Soldiers Medal for bravery in saving the life of a German counterpart during a drug operation; he was wounded during the ordeal.

Led complex contract fraud investigations with far-reaching consequences which resulted in the recoupment of millions of dollars to the U.S. Government.
