Major Accomplishments:

- Responsible for civilianizing the Computer Crime Investigative Unit. Under his leadership the unit successfully investigated the largest cyber crime theft and illegal disclosure of classified information in the nation's history.
- As the Director, Defense Forensics and Biometrics Agency, he was instrumental in improving the quality and timeliness of forensic services to CID agents and combatant commanders.
- Led teams in the recovery of the victims of the terrorist attacks on the Pentagon and served as Force Protection Advisor to the U.S. Congress in the wake of the attacks.
- Tirelessly contributed to the character, doctrine, mission and training of the men and women who fill the CID ranks; ensuring the command remains on a positive trajectory into the future.
