



# Army CID Unpaid Internship Program

## COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY STUDENTS

The Army CID Unpaid Intern Program provides opportunities for college and university students to gain valuable work experience.

This program is designed to provide interns with real-world exposure and experience focused on a variety of investigatory careers or other support fields.

To be eligible applicants must be enrolled not less than half-time in a trade school, technical or vocational institute, junior college, college, university, or comparable educational institution.

Eligible students must also plan to continue their education following the conclusion of their internship. Army CID Field Offices will advertise/collaborate with local colleges and universities concerning these internship opportunities.

Identified applicants should apply a minimum of 90 days from the proposed start of the internship. The Intern Program Manager will conduct a complete background check, to include criminal history, through the National Crime Information Center and applicable records.

Once name checks are cleared and documents verified, the Intern Program Manager will coordinate scheduling the applicant for an interview with the appropriate Field Office, Directorate, or U.S. Army Criminal Investigations Laboratory (USACIL).
