

Army CID Offers a Reward up to \$25,000 for Information Leading to the Arrest and Conviction







The US Army Criminal Investigation Division is seeking the public's help and offering a reward of up to \$25,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the murder of Mrs. Enfinnity Latania Hayes. Mrs. Hayes was shot and killed by an unknown male while at Milford Lake, KS on 3 Oct 21. The unknown gunmen demanded money prior to shooting Mrs. Hayes, and then fled on foot.
