\$10,000 REWARD

The Department of the Army Criminal Investigation Division is offering a reward up to \$10,000 for information leading to the recovery of SGT Jeff A. Coonradt, and/or the successful arrest and conviction of any individuals criminally liable for his disappearance.



SGT Coonradt was 27 years old when he was last seen in Marina, CA, on 20 Dec 87 while riding as a passenger in the car of a fellow unit member. According to that individual, SGT Coonradt jumped from the vehicle while it was stopped at an intersection. SGT Coonradt has not been seen since; however, foul play is suspected in his disappearance.
