

U.S. Army CID Offers a Reward Up to \$25,000.00





The Department of the Army Criminal Investigation Division (CID) is offering a reward for credible information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the murder of Cadet Joseph Banales.

CID and the Selma Police Department are asking for the public's help in identifying suspects and/or witnesses of his murder. On April 15, 2023, at approximately 11:30 P.M., Joseph was shot to death while driving his vehicle on IH-35 North near The Forum at Olympia Parkway, Selma, TX. Selma Police Department identified a vehicle of interest seen driving erratically near the crime scene. The vehicle (believed to be a Nissan 350Z or 370Z) is a dark-in-color, possibly blue, sports car, with loud aftermarket exhaust and possibly a spoiler.
