The Department of the Army Criminal Investigation Division is offering a reward for credible information leading to the identification, arrest, and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the murder of Sgt. 1st Class Tristian Jackson. CID is asking for the public's help in identifying suspects and/or witnesses of his murder. Sgt. 1st Class Jackson was shot in the garage of his mother's home located at 364 Killough Springs Road, Birmingham, AL on January 8, 2020.
