# \$25,000 REWARD

The Department of the Army Criminal Investigation Division is offering a reward of up to \$25,000 for credible information leading to the apprehension of Jesse Bussey. Army CID is working jointly with the United States Marshals Service to bring this fugitive to justice.

Jesse Bussey has been wanted by the U.S. Army since September 1996, after being convicted in absentia at court-martial of sex offenses and desertion in Schweinfurt, Germany. He was sentenced to 16 years in prison, reduction in grade to E-1, and dishonorable discharge. Jesse Bussey was last seen on September 3, 1996, gassing up his 1991 Toyota MR2 at the post shoppette in Schweinfurt, Germany.
