\$50,000 REWARD

The Department of the Army Criminal Investigation Division continues to offer a reward of up to \$50,000 for credible information concerning the circumstances surrounding the death of Spc. Enrique Roman-Martinez. It has been four years since Enrique reported missing, near Cape Lookout National Seashore in North Carolina.



Enrique was last seen camping with fellow Soldiers May 22, 2020, at a campsite on South Core Banks, an island of the Cape Lookout National Seashore. Enrique was reported missing the evening of May 23, 2020. He was last seen wearing blue shorts and no shirt. On May 29, 2020, his remains were found on the shore of Shackleford Banks Island, North Carolina. Army CID encourages anyone with information to please come forward.
