\$10,000 REWARD FOR INFORMATION

The Department of the Army Criminal Investigation Division is offering a reward of up to \$10,000 for credible information leading to the identification, arrest, and conviction of the individual(s) responsible for the murder of Mrs. Tracy L. McMath, a 20 year old military dependent spouse, and her unborn child, in Mannheim, Germany. On September 29, 1987, Mrs. McMath was reported missing by a friend. She was later found deceased in the bathtub of her German apartment. Her ATM card was stolen and used to withdraw \$600 in Kaiserslautern and Heidelberg.
