\$50,000 REWARD

FOR INFORMATION

The Department of the Army Criminal Investigation Division continues to offer a reward of up to \$50,000 for credible information on the death of Specialist Enrique Roman-Martinez. It has been nearly 5 years since Spc. Enrique Roman-Martinez's disappearance and death.



Spc. Enrique Roman-Martinez was last seen on the evening of May 22, 2020, camping with other Soldiers on South Core Banks, part of the Cape Lookout National Seashore in North Carolina.

On May 23, 2020, Spc. Roman-Martinez was reported missing and on May 29, 2020 his partial remains were discovered on the shore of Shackleford Banks Island, North Carolina.

Army CID is determined to bring closure to Spc. Enrique Roman-Martinez's family and is asking the public's help to further this investigation. The payout of cash rewards to military and federal employees for information leading to conviction is contingent upon their exceptional actions regarding the information provided. Army CID reserves the discretion to award the full or a lesser amount based on the quality of information, multiple claimants, or other criteria.
