Army CID is offering a reward up to \$10,000.00 for information leading to the identification of the vehicle and person operating the vehicle which struck and killed Staff Sgt. Eric Rucker. On June 11, 2023, Staff Sgt. Rucker was struck and killed by an apparent gray in color sedan while traveling westbound on the 1900 block of Elms Road around 2:30 a.m. near W.S. Young Drive, Killeen, Texas.
