Special Agent L. Scott Moreland joined the Department of the Army Criminal Investigation Division in June 2004. He serves as the Executive Assistant Director of the Investigations and Operations Directorate (IOD) responsible for overseeing the agency's criminal investigations and operations, including death, sexual assault, narcotics, economic crimes, and national security criminal investigations; and is responsible for manning, training, and equipping of personnel, as well as the execution of major criminal investigative activities, both proactive and reactive, for the Department of the Army.

Prior to his selection to Executive Assistant Director of the Investigations and Operations Directorate, Special Agent Moreland served as the Principal Deputy Assistant Director of DACID's Investigations and Operations Directorate. His prior leadership positions include Deputy Assistant Director, IOD and Special Agent-in-Charge, Fraud Field Office.

Prior to his civilian career with the United States Army, Special Agent Moreland was on active duty in the United States Air Force for 9 years with the last 4 years as a Special Agent with the Air Force Office of Investigations (AFOSI).

Special Agent Moreland holds a Master of Public Administration, Master of Business Administration, and Master of Science Management from Strayer University. He also completed a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice from the University of Maryland and has several associate level degrees. Special Agent Moreland is a Certified Fraud Examiner (CFE) through the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners. His work has been recognized on several occasions including an Award for Excellence and an Outstanding Achievement Award from the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency.
