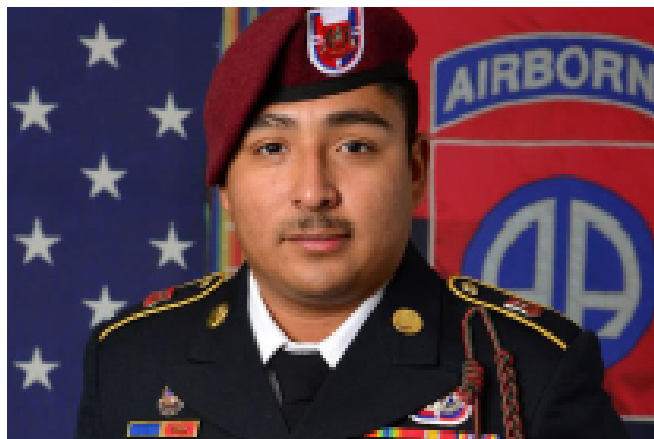




# Department of Army CID Offers a Reward up to **\$50,000.00**



The Department of the Army Criminal Investigation Division is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for credible information concerning the circumstances surrounding the death of SPC Enrique Roman-Martinez who was assigned to Fort Bragg, North Carolina. His partial remains were found near Cape Lookout National Seashore, May 29, 2020. Roman-Martinez was camping with seven fellow Soldiers and was last seen May 22, 2020, at a campsite near Mile Marker 46 on South Core Banks, one of the islands that make up Cape Lookout National Seashore. Roman-Martinez's friends reported him missing the evening of May 23, 2020.
