Army CID Offers Reward for Stolen Equipment

QUANTICO, VA, (March 21, 2019) – The U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command, commonly referred to as CID, is offering a reward of up to \$8,000.00 to anyone with information leading to the identification and successful prosecution of the person or persons involved in the theft of the following military equipment from Fort Bliss, Texas.

- 36 Mechanic Toolboxes (Figure 1) from the Supply Area of Forward Support Company, 1-37th Armored, 2nd Heavy Brigade Combat Team, located at Bldg. 20515 Old Ironsides Rd. The items are believed to have been stolen between July 24, 2018 and August 13, 2018.
- 104 Avon M50 Protective Masks (Figure 2) from the Supply Area of Bravo Company, 86th Expeditionary Signal Battalion, located at Bldg. 21105, Quarter Master Ave. The items are believed to have been stolen between September 22 and 24, 2018.
- 27 Avon M50 Protective Masks from the Supply Area of Alpha Company, 3-41 Infantry Regiment, 1st Stryker Brigade Combat Team, located at Bldg. 21285 Quarter Master Ave. The items are believed to have been stolen on November 7, 2018.
- 19 Avon M50 Protective Masks and 12 HP Laptops from the Supply Area of Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, Division Artillery located at Bldg. 21145

Quarter Master Rd. The items are believed to have been stolen on December 7, 2018.
